The Seattle Symphony invites young people ages 8-18 to attend Wyckoff Masterworks Season performances FREE with the purchase of an adult ticket. The program, "Family Connections," is an initiative of our new Music Director, Ludovic Morlot, who has a passion for igniting the spark of imagination in young audiences and making the Symphony more accessible to families.

How does it work?

- Through the "Family Connections" program, the Seattle Symphony is making 60 tickets available for each of the 53 Masterworks Season performances in the 2011-2012 Season, for a total of 3,180 free tickets.
- Passes will become available three weeks prior to each concert date and may be used by parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, music teachers, mentors — anyone who brings a child ages 8-18 to a Masterworks concert.
- When you purchase a regularly-priced ticket in sections C, D and E (regular adult prices for these sections are \$49, \$39, and \$29, respectively) for yourself, you may request up to two Family Connections passes per order.
- Passes will be specially-marked tickets that must be used by kids and teens ages 8-18.
- Passes are subject to availability; no adjustments for previous purchases

Family Connections passes are only available by phone and in person at the Seattle Symphony Ticket Office.
