Seattle Symphony initiated Young Artists Auditions in 2007 to provide young musicians who have achieved an extraordinary level of performance on their chosen instrument with the opportunity to go through the audition process with the Music Director, staff and musicians of a top-tier orchestra. This invaluable experience is provided free of charge to applicants and is an integral part of Seattle Symphony's commitment to youth, music education, and community.

Seattle Symphony Young Artists Audition Guidelines:

- Seattle Symphony artistic staff will listen to all CD recordings and select applicants who will be invited to audition in person.
- Audition scheduling priority may be given to applicants who are not yet graduated from high school, who have not auditioned before, who are recommended by Seattle Symphony musicians, and/or by music festival and competition representatives. <u>Please note: letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application and CD recording.</u>
- After hearing auditions, the Music Director may consider exceptional participants for possible solo
  performance on education, family or community concert programs. Final decisions regarding soloists
  selected for performance rest with the Music Director with recommendations from musicians, artistic
  and education staff.
- Seattle Symphony Young Artists Auditions for the 2016-2017 season will be held on Wednesday, April 20, 2016, 2:00 5:00pm. Auditions will take place in the Illsley Ball Nordstrom Recital Hall. Ludovic Morlot, Seattle Symphony Music Director, will preside.

If you are selected to audition, you will be contacted by Symphony staff by email and/or phone numbers provided on the application for further instructions.

Please mail your application, any letters of recommendation, and CD recording postmarked by Monday, February 22, 2016. No phone calls please.
